

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 90-73

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 13-71
BEING A BY-LAW WITH RESPECT TO A SEWAGE
RATE UNDER SECTION 16a AND 42 (6) OF THE
ONTARIO WATER RESOURCES ACT.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City
of North Bay deems it advisable to amend By-law No. 13-71.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law No. 13-71 is hereby amended by changing the present
Clause 2 to read 2 (a) and inserting a clause which
shall become Clause 2 (b); said Clause to read as
follows:

"2 (b) Notwithstanding the above, where water is
supplied by the Corporation of the City of
North Bay to lands that are used for com-
mercial or industrial purposes and such
water is not discharged, deposited or
emitted back into the sewage system, a
reduction of the sewage rate be made thereon
sufficient having regard to the situation
to adjust the surcharge to compensate for
the rate charged to the municipality by
the Ontario Water Resources Commission
for sewer service pursuant to the terms
of an Agreement between the municipality
and the Ontario Water Resources Commission
dated the 23rd of June, 1973."

2. Clause 3 (a) is hereby amended by replacing the figures
33.33 percent with 100 lineal feet so that the Clause
will now read as follows:

"3 (a) A reduction in the case of corner lots at
the junction or intersection of streets of
100 lineal feet of the flankage and a re-
duction or increase in the case of trian-
gular or irregularly shaped lots may be
made in the foot frontage rate that other-
wise would be chargeable thereon, sufficient
having regard to the situation, value and
superficial area of such lots as compared
with other lots, to adjust its frontage
charge on a fair and equitable basis."

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 27th DAY OF AUGUST, 1973.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 10TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1973.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS
16TH DAY OF JUNE, 1975.
