BY-LAW NUMBER 531

BEING a By-law to provide for the Collection, Removal, and Disposal of Ashes, Food Garbage and other refuse.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, to pass a By-law regulating the Collection, Removal, and Disposal of Ashes, Food Garbage, and other refuse within the limits of the said Town, and to provide for the payment for service rendered by the Municipality in connection with the said work.

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay as follows;-

1. That all former By-laws regulating the collection and disposal of garbage be and the same are hereby repealed.
2. That the Collection, Removal and Disposal of Ashes, Food Garbage, and other refuse, be performed under the supervision of the Sanitary Inspector and Town Engineer.
3. That no pit closets shall be used within the limits of the Town of North Bay.
4. That all closets must conform with the standard plan of closet hereby adopted by the Corporation of the Town of North Bay, and hereto attached. That all existing pit closets must be remodelled to comply as nearly as possible with the said sketch and those closets which cannot be so remodelled are to be replaced by new closets.
5. That all closets shall be constructed and maintained fly proof.
6. That all closets must be equipped with the standard pail or bucket of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay.
 - (a) The standard bucket shall have the following dimensions

7. That all closets within the limits of the Town of North Bay must be kept clean and buckets emptied and cleaned twice a month or oftener if necessary, the cost of which service shall be borne by the Municipality at large and included in the general rate of taxation for each year.
8. It shall be the duty of the driver of every night soil wagon to thoroughly wash his wagon and disinfect it with Chloride of Lime or other disinfectant supplied by the Corporation, after every load has been dumped, between the first day of April and the First Day of December in each year.
9. If after one month's notice in writing from the Sanitary Inspector the occupant of any premises not located on a public sewer has failed to provide standard buckets or pails as required by the Health Act, the same may be supplied by this Department and the cost thereof added to the Collector's Roll for collection as part of the expense of cleaning and disposing of the contents of such privys, earth closets, privy vaults, or dry earth closets, and such occupant so failing shall also be liable to the penalty hereinafter provided.
10. When any dumb animal shall die within the limits of the Town, the owner shall at his own expense, within twelve hours thereafter cause the carcass to be removed to the place provided by the Municipality, and there disposed of as the Sanitary Inspector may direct.
11. That proper covered metal garbage cans and pails must be maintained by Fruit Dealers, Fish Dealers, Grocers, Butchers, Ice Cream Vendors, Candy Manufacturers, Confectioners, Boarding Houses, Hotels and Restaurants within the limits of the Town of North Bay for the purpose of depositing food garbage therein as it is created, and barrells for collection of tin cans and other refuse.
12. That food garbage cans and barrells with other refuse

must be emptied and cleaned and subject to paragraph (13) the food garbage and refuse must be removed to the place provided by the Municipality, three times a week by the owner at his own expense .

13. That any party may contract with the Corporation of the Town of North Bay to collect, remove, and dispose of his or her food garbage and refuse at the rates and charges hereinafter set forth.

14. That parties who have contracted with the Corporation of the Town of North Bay for collection, removal, and disposal of their food garbage and other refuse, shall also have their ashes collected and removed, provided the same are clean and deposited in buckets or barrels conveniently placed for collection.

15. That collection, removal and disposal of ashes and food garbage and other refuse shall be extended to private houses, who desire the service, under the same rules and regulations as applied to those parties under clause (12)

16. That the rates and charges to be charged and collected for the collection, removal and disposal of ashes, food garbage and other refuse, within the limits of the Town of North Bay, shall be those set forth in Schedule "A" hereto annexed or in any amending Schedule that may hereafter be made by the Corporation. And that the afore-said rates and charges shall be collected two months in advance by the Sanitary Inspector.

17. Any person committing a breach of this By-law will be liable to a fine of not more than \$10.00 for the first offence and to not more than \$20 for each subsequent offence, together with costs of Court. Any fine not paid forthwith, is to be collected if possible by distress of the goods and chattels of the party liable for payment of the said fine, and costs, and in default of distress, the said party may be convicted to the common gaol in the Town of North Bay for a term of not more than ten days.

18. This By-law shall take effect immediately after the passing thereof.

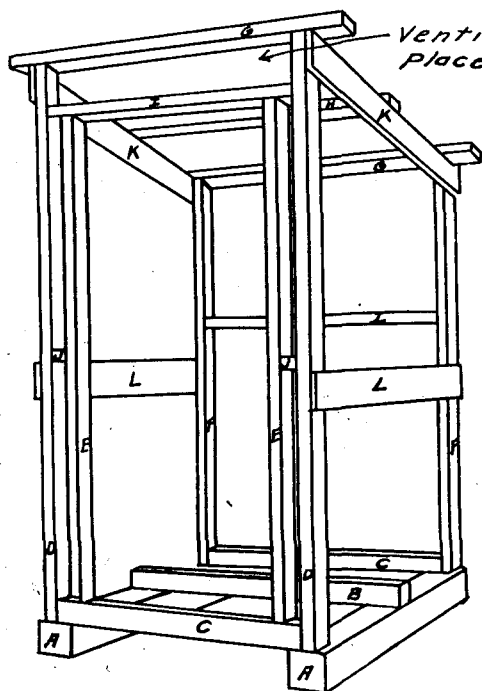
Schedule of rates and charges for collection, removal and disposal of ashes, and garbage, the same being yearly charges except when otherwise specified.

1. Boarding House	\$18.00
2. Butchers	36.00
3. Candy Manufacturers	36.00
4. Confectioners	36.00
5. Fish Dealers	36.00
6. Fruit Dealers	36.00
7. Grocers	36.00
8. Hotel	90.00
9. Ice Cream Vendors	36.00
10. Private Houses	9.00
11. Restaurants	54.00
12. Garbage per can and barrell	.15
13. Ashes per load	1.50
14. Where a party carries on one or more than one business as classes in the above schedule, he shall pay full charge for one class and fifty per cent of the charge for each additional class over and above two additional ones.	

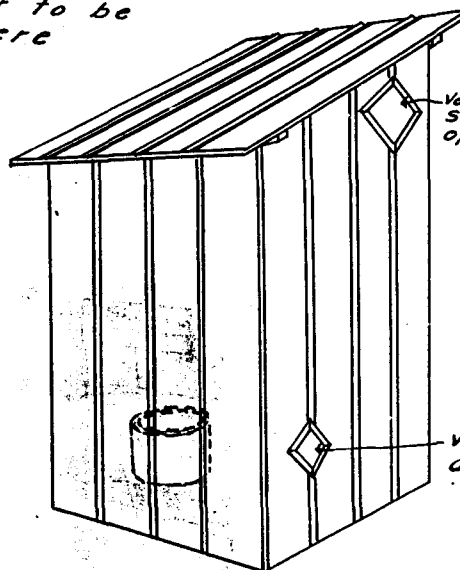
SKETCH
