

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 120-70

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH LAIDLAW-GOODWOOD INDUSTRIES LIMITED PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF FIRE-FIGHTING EQUIPMENT OF THE SAID CORPORATION.

WHEREAS paragraph (1) of Section 377 of The Municipal Act of the Province of Ontario provides that by-laws may be passed by the councils of all municipalities for entering into agreement with any other municipality or person for the use of fire-fighting equipment;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of North Bay has agreed to enter upon such agreement with Laidlaw-Goodwood Industries Limited as hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is authorized to enter into an Agreement with Laidlaw-Goodwood Industries Limited whereby the said Corporation will provide to the said Company fire-fighting services and equipment, in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part hereof.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are authorized and empowered to execute the said Agreement on behalf of the Corporation and to affix thereto the Corporate Seal.
