BY-LAW NO. 2004-164

**BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, CLOSE AND CONVEY  
A PORTION OF THE ETHEL STREET ROAD  
ALLOWANCE IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

**WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the road allowance hereinafter described be closed, stopped up and conveyed;

**AND WHEREAS** approval of the closing of the Ethel Street road allowance was approved by Council by Resolution No. 2001-479 on July 23, 2001;

**AND WHEREAS** notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

**AND WHEREAS** Council has heard from any person or by his/her counsel, solicitor or agent, who has claimed that his/her lands, will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. That certain road allowance shown on Registered Plan 55 and Registered Plan 100 in the City of North Bay designated as Parts 1, 2, 3 & 4, Plan 36R-11154, is hereby deemed surplus.
2. That certain road allowance shown on Registered Plan 55 and Registered Plan 100 in the City of North Bay designated as Parts 1, 2, 3 & 4, Plan 36R-11154, is hereby closed and stopped up.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 4<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER, 2004.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THE 18<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER, 2004.
