

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2326

Being a By-law to amend By-law No. 2278 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, being a By-law to amend By-law No. 2100 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, relating to the adoption of certain policy matters.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend By-law No. 2278 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay as hereinafter set forth;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That By-law No. 2278 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay be amended by adding thereto Paragraph 17(a) (iii) (a) as hereinafter set forth:

17(a) (iii)(a) Notwithstanding anything contained in By-law No. 2100 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay as amended by By-law No. 2278 aforesaid, where a petition properly signed by the owners on both sides of a street praying that a paved street be resurfaced and widened in excess of twenty-four feet, such widening shall be undertaken on a local improvement basis and charged against the abutting owners.

The aforesaid widening shall not be undertaken unless approved of by the City Engineer and City Council.

- 2. This By-law shall come into full force and effect as of the date of the final passing thereof.

 READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 24TH DAY OF OCT. 1966.
 READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 24TH DAY OF OCT. 1966.
