THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 95-70

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1438 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is considered advisable to amend By-law No. 1438 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay in certain respects as hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The paragraph immediately following Section 21 of said By-law and immediately preceding Section 23 of said By-law which paragraph reads as follows:

PENALTY

"Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting magistrate a penalty of not less than \$1.00 and not exceeding (exclusive of costs) the sum of \$50.00 for each such offence." is deleted,

and the following substituted therefor:

"22. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting judge or magistrate, a fine or penalty not exceeding the sum of \$300.00 for each offence, exclusive of costs, to be recoverable under The Summary Convictions Act."
