

BY-LAW NUMBER 542

By-Law 542

BEING a By-law granting certain exemptions on account of Military, Naval or Air Service.

WHEREAS an Act of Parliament was passed by the Local Legislature for the Province of Ontario in the year 1915, entitled "The Provincial War Tax Act of 1915" providing for the raising of certain moneys in the different municipalities in the Province, such moneys being known as the "Provincial War Tax."


AND WHEREAS it is provided under the said Act that the councils or towns in the Province of Ontario may pass by-laws exempting from any rate to be imposed under the said Act, any person engaged in the active military or naval or any service of his Majesty, and any person who is the father, mother, wife or child of a person so serving, and who is dependent upon him for support.


BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY, as follows:-

1. Any person engaged under Active, Military, Naval, or Air Service of his Majesty and also any person who is the father, mother wife, or child of a person so serving and who is dependent upon him for support may upon application to the council have the amount levied against him under the said Provincial War Tax Act struck off for the current year.
2. This exemption is not to reduce or affect the amount so to be raised, levied and paid over by the Municipality of North Bay, and the amount of every exemption granted under this Act shall be raised, levied and collected from the remainder of the rateable property in the Municipality.
3. This by-law is passed under the provisions of the Statutes of Ontario 5 George V, chap. 3, sec. 8.

This by-law is to take effect immediately after the passing thereof.
