

*Amended by By-Law 1657*

BEING a By-Law to amend By-Law 1464 and amendments thereto as such are affected by this By-Law, all of which being By-Laws regulating the Traffic on the Public Highways of the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend said By-Law 1464 and amendments thereto.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 39A By-Law 1570 a By-Law amending By-Law 1464 be repealed and substituted with the following new section, as Section 39B.

"SECTION 39B: Medical Doctors, Members of the North Bay Medical Association.

That Sections 31 and 32 of By-Law 1464 shall not apply to Passenger Motor Vehicles of the aforementioned Medical Doctors, provided the owner of such Passenger Motor Vehicle has applied and paid for Parking privileges at the annual rate of \$30.00 per year for a one car parking space. The Chief Constable to allocate the private parking space for such Medical Doctors. That all such spaces when allocated be clearly marked Medical Profession Private Parking and numbered to agree with each paid application."

2. That By-Law 1466 a By-Law amending By-Law 1464 be amended by adding the following after the number 3 in line 4 of Clause 1 of the said By-Law 1466:

"except on Sundays and on weekdays when motorists park to attend regular or special church service with a qualified member of the Clergy in attendance."

So that Clause 1 of By-Law 1466 will now read as follows:

"When properly worded signs have been erected and are on display, no person shall park a vehicle on any of the streets or parts of streets hereinafter set out in Column 1 on the side or sides of the streets as set out in Column 2 during the period set out in Column 3 except on Sundays and on weekdays when motorists park to attend regular or special church service with a qualified member of the Clergy in attendance."

3. That Clause 0 of Section 1 of By-Law 1466 be deleted from this Section and added as a new section to be written into By-Law 1464 as Section 12A, Clause 1, so as to read:

"SECTION 12A, CLAUSE 1: No vehicle shall be parked on any street all night."

4. That By-Law 1464 be amended by adding the following as Clause C of Section 6.

"SECTION 6, CLAUSE C: No left hand turns are permitted from Main Street West onto Algonquin Avenue. That this section shall not become effective until suitable signs have been erected indicating the restriction."

5. That Clause D of Section 1 of By-Law 1466 a By-Law amending By-Law 1464 be amended to read:


"McIntyre St. from Cassell St. to Lot 224  
McIntyre St. from Lot 222 to Sherbrooke St."

6. That By-Laws 1464 and 1466 and all other By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law are hereby necessarily amended or repealed.


