

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 57-74

BEING A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO ENTER INTO THAT CERTAIN AGREEMENT DATED THE 9TH DAY OF APRIL, 1974, BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AND EDWARD SMOWTON AND DOROTHEA SMOWTON RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF THE MUNICIPAL TRAILER CAMP IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable and necessary to enter into the Agreement hereinafter referred to, upon and subject to the terms and conditions therein set forth.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the Corporation of the City of North Bay do enter into that certain Agreement dated the 9th day of April, 1974, between the Corporation of the City of North Bay and Edward Smowton and Dorothea Smowton relating to the operation of the Municipal Trailer Camp in the City of North Bay upon and subject to the terms and conditions therein set forth.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute the aforesaid Agreement dated the 9th day of April, 1974 on behalf of the Corporation of the City of North Bay and to affix thereto the Corporate Seal.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 13TH DAY OF MAY, 1974.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 13TH DAY OF MAY, 1974.
