

BY-LAW NO. 1663

BEING A BY-LAW to prohibit the taking or soliciting of subscriptions to magazines upon any Highway or in any Public Place in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay have been requested to pass a by-law to prohibit the taking or soliciting of subscriptions to magazines upon any highway or in any public place in the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL ACT, SECTION 406, SUB-SECTION 4, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) No person, or persons shall take or solicit subscriptions to magazines upon any Highway or in any Public Place in the City of North Bay.
- (2) Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) exclusive of costs of each offence and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs forthwith the said penalty and costs or costs only may be levied by distress and sale of goods and titles of the offender and in case of there being no distress found out of which such penalty can be levied the convicting magistrate may commit the offender to the common jail with or without hard labour for any period not exceeding twenty-one days. Unless the penalty and costs, if any, including the cost of the said distress and the committal and conveyance of the offender to the said jail are sooner paid.
