

BY-LAW NUMBER 708.

BEING A BY-LAW to establish a Public Park in the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Town of North Bay are the owners of Lots Numbers One Hundred and Forty (140) and One Hundred and Forty-One (141) on Cassells Street, in the said Town of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to establish said lots as a public park in the Town of North Bay.

THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted that the following lands and premises be, and the same are hereby established as a public park in the Town of North Bay, namely: ALL AND SINGULAR that certain Parcel or tract of land and premises, situated, lying and being in the Town of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing and Province of Ontario and being composed of Lots Numbers One Hundred and Forty (140) and One Hundred and Forty-One, Cassells Street, in the said Town of North Bay, according ~~according~~ as the said lots are shown on a Plan of part of the Town of North Bay, prepared by John H. Shaw, Esquire, O. L. S. and registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing on the Eleventh day of January, A. D. 1905.
