BY-LAW NO. 4-89

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 127-71, AS AMENDED BY BY-LAW NO. 94-80, BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH, REGULATE AND PROVIDE A SYSTEM FOR THE HANDLING, COLLECTION, REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH, ASHES AND OTHER WASTE DISPOSAL IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS Council deems it advisable to amend By-Law 127-71 to include trailer parks in the definition of "multi-residential building."

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section (g) of By-Law 127-71 is hereby amended by deleting Section (g) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
 - "multi-residential building" means a building with a single municipal address having more than two (2) residential dwelling units which is principally used or held out to be used for apartment or townhouse accommodation and excluding any building used or held out to be used for hotel or motel accommodation but shall include a mobile home/trailer as a dwelling unit provided each trailer/mobile home is served by an individual hydro service, the unit is permanently occupied and is in excess of 30 feet in length.
- 2. That this By-Law shall come into force upon being finally passed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 16TH DAY OF JANUARY 1989.
