BY-LAW NO. 121-98

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE LICENSING BY-LAW NO. 139-95 TO ELIMINATE TRANSIENT TRADER LICENSES AND AMEND LICENSING FEES FOR RESIDENT HAWKERS AND PEDDLARS

WHEREAS By-Law No. 139-95 establishes the issuance of licenses and their respective fees in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS due to legislative changes to eliminate "Business Taxes", it is deemed desirable to amend the By-law to eliminate Transient Trader Licenses and to amend the licensing fee for Resident Hawker and Peddlars.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- l. Licensing ByLaw No. 139-95 is hereby amended by deleting Section 1.6.
- 2. Licensing By-Law No. 139-95 is hereby amended by adding the following clause to Section 2.4:
 - "(7) if the person is a tenant of a building in which he or she offers for sale goods, wares or merchandise."
- 3. Licensing By-Law No. 139-95 is hereby amended by deleting Sections 2.8 and 2.9.
- 4. Schedule 1 of Licensing By-Law No. 139-95 is hereby amended by deleting the fee of \$250.00 for the first location and \$100.00 for each additional location for Resident Hawkers and Peddlarss and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"Residents of North Bay

\$100.00 per location per annum"

- 5. Schedule 1 of Licensing By-Law No. 139-95 is hereby amended by deleting the fee for Transient Traders.
- 6. Schedule 6 of Licensing By-Law No. 139-95 is hereby amended by adding the following to Clause No. 9:
 - "(g) by a person who is a tenant of a building in which he or she offers for sale goods, wares or merchandise."
- 7. Licensing By-Law No. 139-95 is further amended by deleting Schedule 12 relating to Transient Traders from the by-law.
- 8. This by-law comes into effect as of and from September 1, 1998.
