

BY-LAW NO. 1842

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay respecting Engineering Etc. for proposed sewage works project.

WHEREAS the Ontario Water Resources Commission has requested the Municipal Corporation to enact the following By-law in order to facilitate the proceeding with the engineering on a certain proposed sewage works project at North Bay.

AND WHEREAS this by-law is to provide for the appointment of a consulting engineer by the Ontario Water Resources Commission and the reimbursement of the Commission by the Municipality for engineering and incidental costs up to the time of calling tenders in the event the venture should fail;

AND WHEREAS it is not the intention of the Ontario Water Resources Commission to proceed with construction of the project until the same has been duly approved by the Ontario Municipal Board and otherwise.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Municipality endorses the appointment by the Ontario Water Resources Commission of Graham Reid and Associates Limited as consulting engineer on the said project;
2. In the event the venture should fail the Municipality shall pay or reimburse the Commission not more than 80% of all such engineering or incidental costs incurred by the Commission in preparation of the details of the proposed project up to the time of final receiving of tenders.
