By-Law No. 2016-112

Being a By-Law to Designate Lots on a Certain Plan of Subdivision that has been Registered for Eight (8) Years or More as Deemed not to be on a Registered Plan of Subdivision

18 Maplevue Place

Whereas it is provided by The Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, s. 50(4) that the Council of a municipality may by-law designate any plan of subdivision that has been registered for eight (8) years or more not to be a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of subsection 4 of The Planning Act;

And Whereas in the opinion of the Council it is desirable that Lot 4 of Plan No. 36M-690, being the plan of subdivision referred to herein, be deemed not to be lots on a registered plan of subdivision in order to expand the property holdings to accommodate the construction of a detached garage.

And Whereas the Council passed Resolution 2016-491 at its Meeting on Monday October 31, 2016 authorizing that a Deeming By-law be adopted to deem Lots 296 and 297, Plan 86 not to be lots on a Registered Plan of Subdivision.

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay Hereby Enacts as follows:

1. Lot 4 of Plan No. 36M-690 in the City of North Bay, are hereby deemed not to be lots on a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of section 4 of Section 50 of The Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13.
2. That the Clerk of The Corporation of the City of North Bay shall:
 - i. lodge a certified copy of this by-law in the office of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing;
 - ii. register a certified copy of this by-law in the proper Land Titles Office; and
 - iii. send by registered mail, notice of the passing of this by-law to each person appearing by the last revised assessment roll to be the owner of the land to which this by-law applies, within 30 days of the passing of this by-law.
3. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon being finally passed.
