

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 76-71

BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE AND STOP UP PART OF A CERTAIN LANEWAY.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of North Bay has been requested to close and stop up a portion of the laneway which is hereinafter described;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law and has applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, by the Council of the said City or a Committee of said Council;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Upon and after the passing of this by-law, that portion of a certain laneway described in detail in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part hereof shall be closed and stopped up.
2. This by-law shall take effect forthwith upon the passing thereof.

THIS IS SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW NO. 76-71 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

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All and singular the lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing and being composed of that portion of a laneway shown on Plan 57 registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing which said land is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the south west angle of Lot 72 according to said plan;

Thence southerly a distance of fourteen feet (14') more or less to the north west angle of Lot 71;

Thence easterly along the north boundary of Lot 71, a distance of one-hundred and thirty-two feet (132') to the north east angle of said lot;

Thence northerly a distance of fourteen feet (14') to the south east angle of Lot 73;

Thence westerly along the southerly boundaries of Lots 73 and 72, a distance of one-hundred and thirty-two feet (132') to the point of commencement.
