

BY-LAW NO. 2107

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay regulating and governing the owners of Barber Shops and requiring the closing of Barber Shops during certain hours.

WHEREAS this Council has been requested by owners of Barber Shops within the City of North Bay to pass a by-law for the purposes set out in the next preceding paragraph;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS THAT:

1. In this by-law, Barber Shop shall mean any establishment catering primarily to men, offering services in the nature of cutting of hair, styling of hair, special treatment of hair or scalp, tinting, dyeing, shampooing or any of such services or any other service related or incidental to same.
2. In this by-law, wherever an expression of time occurs, it shall be taken to mean Standard Time or Daylight Saving Time whichever system of time is currently being observed in the City of North Bay.
3. All Barber Shops in the City of North Bay shall be closed and remain closed on each and every day of the week at and during the hours between six o'clock in the afternoon of any day and five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day, except as hereinafter provided.
4. All Barber Shops within the City of North Bay shall be closed and remain closed on Wednesday of each and every week during the whole of such day and until five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day, excepting the Wednesday immediately preceding Good Friday, Christmas Day and January 1st, in each and every year, when the provisions of this section shall not apply.
5. No Barber Shop shall be opened in a place of residence within the City of North Bay unless and until such Barber Shop complies with the requirements of the by-laws of the City of North Bay.
6. No person shall engage in the business of, or operate, a Barber Shop within the City of North Bay, without first having obtained a certificate from the Department of Labour, except those persons who, with the approval of the Department of Labour, are working as apprentices to such Barbers.
7. Every barber within the City of North Bay who has been awarded a certificate from the Department of Labour shall exhibit the same in a conspicuous position on the premises where he carries on business as a barber and where it may be viewed by any customer.
8. By-law No. 1967 and any amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
9. This By-law shall take effect on the 1st day of June 1963 and shall be deemed to be published sufficiently by the consideration and passing of same in open Council, to ensure the publicity thereof.
10. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law shall, upon conviction, forfeit and pay at the discretion of the Convicting Magistrate a penalty, exclusive of costs, of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$300.00 for each offence.
