

BY-LAW NO. 1963

BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH COMMUNITY CENTRES and a Board for the management thereof, within the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS this Council deems it expedient to provide for the establishment of certain Community centres in accordance with the provisions of the Community Centres Act RSO 1960, Chapter 60 and amendments thereto.

AND WHEREAS the said Act provides that every community centre so established shall be under the management and control of a Board appointed by the Council of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT the following community centres be and the same are hereby established, namely:-

1. Canadian Legion, Fisher St. Athletic Field
2. Elks Community Hall
3. Elks Community Athletic Field
4. Kinette Community Hall
5. Kinette Community Athletic Field
6. Kiwanis Community Hall
7. Kiwanis Community Athletic Field
8. Kings Castle Athletic Field
9. Kinsmen Beach Athletic Field
10. Amelia Beach Athletic Field
11. Amelia Park Athletic Field
12. Lee Park Athletic Field
13. Chippewa Creek Athletic Field
14. Canadian Legion Community Memorial Hall
15. Canadian Legion Community Memorial Athletic
16. Bourke Community Hall
17. Bourke Community Athletic Field
18. Victoria Community Hall
19. Victoria Community Athletic Field

2. Each and every of the said community centres and all other community centres which may hereinafter be established under the provisions of the said Act, shall be under the management and control of a Board appointed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay, which shall be known as the Community Centres Management Board, or such other Board as is designated by City Council from time to time and which shall be composed of seven members, at least two of which shall be elected members of City Council to be appointed annually.

3. Any vacancy arising on the Community Centres Management Board may be filled by Council.
4. The representatives of the Council shall be appointed annually and shall hold office until their successors are appointed and every other member of the Board shall hold office until his successor is appointed.
5. The Community Centres Management Board may, subject to approval by City Council, make such rules as it deems necessary relating to the management and control of the said community centres and may fix such charges for the use of same as it deems advisable.
6. Any local organization, society or other body by which any community centre established under this Act may be used under the regulations, may make grants out of any monies in their hands in aid of the erection and/or maintenance of a community centre established hereunder.
7. No community centre established hereunder shall be sold or disposed of within twenty years from the time aid was last granted to such community centre out of monies appropriated therefor by the Legislature, without the approval of the Minister.
8. All banking records and books of account pertaining to the building, maintenance, and operation of every community centre established hereunder, shall be under the jurisdiction of the City Treasurer, and the signing authorities shall be the same as the signing authorities for the City of North Bay.
9. The said Board shall submit to Council on or before the 1st day of March in each and every year, an estimate of revenue and expenditures on account of each of the said Community Centres for the current year and after being duly approved by Council such estimates shall not be over-expended without prior approval by Resolution of the Council.
10. The said Board of Management shall forward to Council a monthly statement of revenue and expenditures:-
11. The Board of Management shall:-
 - (a) Appoint a Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary from among its members
 - (b) Appoint the time and place of its meetings

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- (c) Make regulations respecting the proceedings and procedure at its meetings.
- (d) Keep proper and correct minutes of all of its meetings
- (e) Deliver to Council immediately following every meeting, a copy of the Minutes of such meeting.
- (f) Report fully and punctually to Council on any other business conducted by the said Board, upon request so to do by Council.


12. THAT By-laws No. 1928 and No. 1944 be hereby repealed.
