

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 128-70

BEING A BY-LAW PASSED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT ACT, R.S.O. 1960, CHAPTER 223, SECTION 8, DECLARING IT IS DESIRABLE THAT THE CONSTRUCTION OF A 24 FOOT GRAVEL ROADWAY WITH THREE FOOT SHOULDERS AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE "A" TO THIS BY-LAW SHOULD BE UNDERTAKEN AS A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of The Local Improvement Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 223, Section 8, it is hereby declared it is desirable that the construction of a 24 foot gravel roadway with three foot shoulders in the City of North Bay as specified and described in Schedule "A" attached (and which said Schedule "A" be deemed to be incorporated in and form a part of this By-law) should be undertaken as a local improvement.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 2nd DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1970.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 2nd DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1970.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 2nd DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1970.

THIS IS SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW NO. 128-70 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

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Construction of a 24 foot gravel roadway with three foot shoulders on a road allowance between Lots 34 and 35, Concession 15 from Birch's Road northerly a distance of approximately 1550 feet.
