THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2423

Being a By-law to further amend By-law No. 1896 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay known as the Traffic By-law.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable and necessary to further amend By-law No. 1896 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law No. 1896 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
- (a) SECTION ONE DEFINITIONS is amended by adding after the words "For the purpose of this By-law" the words "and Schedules thereto and which said Schedules shall be deemed to be incorporated in and form a part of this By-law."
- (b) SECTION ONE DEFINITIONS is amended by adding the following paragraphs:
 - (1)(a) "Automatic Meter" shall include a parking meter or other mechanical meter or device, with the necessary standard for the same, for the purpose of controlling and regulating the parking of any vehicle on the highway and measuring and recording the duration of such parking;
 - (10)(a) "Dime" as used in this By-law or on a parking meter shall mean a Dominion of Canada or United States of America coin of the denomination of ten cents;
 - (13)(a) "Holiday" shall mean:
 (i) New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday,
 Christmas Day, Boxing Day, the birthday or the
 day fixed by proclamation of the Governor General
 for the celebration of the birthday of the reigning
 Sovereign, Victoria Day, Dominion Day, Labour
 Day and any day appointed by proclamation of the
 Governor General or the Lieutenant Governor as
 a public holiday or for a general fast or thanksgiving, and when any holiday, except Remembrance
 Day, falls on a Sunday, the day next following
 is in lieu thereof a holiday;
 (ii) Any day proclaimed by the head of the
 Council of The Corporation of the City of North
 Bay as a Civic holiday;
 (iii) Sunday;
 - (18)(a) "Nickel" as used in this By-law or on a parking meter shall mean a Dominion of Canada or United States of America large size coin of the denomination of five cents;
 - (28)(a) "Time" So long as the time commonly observed in the City of North Bay is one hour in advance of standard time, the times mentioned in By-law No. 1896 aforesaid and all amendments thereto, including this By-law, shall be reckoned in accordance with the time so commonly observed and not standard time.

- (c) Schedule "J" Parts A, B and C and Schedule "K" of By-law No. 1896 aforesaid, as amended, are hereby repealed and Schedule "J"
 Parts, A, B, C, D (and E) and Schedule "K" attached hereto shall
 be substituted in lieu thereof. "and E" - Not approved
- SECTION TWENTY-SIX (2) of By-law No. 1896 aforesaid, as amended, (d) is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - (a) The streets, parts of streets and sides of streets and City of North Bay parking lots (Civic Parking Lots) set forth and described in Schedule "J" Parts A, B, C, D (and E) are "and E" Not hereby established and designated as parking meter zones approved and outsmatic meters shall be arrested maintained and approved and automatic meters shall be erected, maintained and operated thereon on the days and during the hours set forth in Schedule "K" to this By-law.
- SECTION TWENTY-SIX (3) of By-law No. 1896 aforesaid, as amended, (e) is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - The driver of a vehicle parked in a parking meter zone on any of the days and between or during any of the hours set forth and specified in Schedule "K" to this By-law shall make use of the automatic meter immediately adjacent to the parking space within which such vehicle is parked and pay for parking such vehicle the fee as set forth in Schedule "k".
- 2. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof and upon receiving the approval of the Ontario Department of Transport.

The following respective parking fees are hereby established for the respective parking zones as set forth in Schedule "J" Parts A, B, C, D(and E)to By-law No. 1896 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, as amended, and such parking fees shall be payable between and during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday of each week and between and during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Thursday and Friday of each week. No parking fee shall be payable on a holiday as hereinbefore defined.

"and E" - not approved

- Schedule "J" Part A One nickel for each thirty minutes or fraction thereof;
- Schedule "J" Part B One nickel for each thirty minutes or fraction thereof and two nickels or one dime for each sixty minutes or fraction thereof in excess of thirty minutes;
- Schedule "J" Part C For each sixty minutes or fraction thereof, one nickel; for two hours or any fraction thereof in excess of one hour, two nickels or one dime;
- Schedule "J" Part D For each sixty minutes or fraction thereof, one nickel;
- Schedule "J" Part E Parking lots owned or leased by
 The Corporation of the City of North
 Bay: one nickel for each thirty
 minutes or fraction thereof and
 two nickels or fraction thereof
 sixty minutes or fraction thereof
 in excess of thirty minutes.
