By-Law 534

BEING a By-law to issue permits to any person to enter upon, hold and use vacant land for the purpose of Food Production.

WHEREAS under and by virtue of the provisions of "The Vacant Land Cultivation Act" of the Province of Ontario, the Councils of Cities, Towns, and Villages, may pass By-laws to issue permits to any person to enter upon, hold and use vacant land for the purpose of cultivation.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to pass such a By-law.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay and it is hereby enacted as follows;-


- (1) That the Agriculture Committee of the Council of the Town of North Bay are hereby authorized, subject to sections 2 & 3 to issue permits to any person to enter upon, hold and use for the purpose only of cultivating it and raising thereon such crops as may be prescribed, any vacant land within the limits of the Town of North Bay, for the period of the duration of the present war, as may be thought proper, and to regulate and control the use of such vacant land by any person to whom the permit is granted, and to prescribe the kinds of crops which shall be raised on any such land, and to revoke any such permit for failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the regulations.
- (2) That before issuing a permit with respect to any parcel of land, notice of intention to issue the permit and fixing a day for hearing objections shall be left with the owner or transmitted to him by post, to the address of his residence if he resides there, and if he is not resident in the Municipality, then by post to his address.
- (3) That no permit with respect to any parcel of land shall be issued if the owner produces proof to the satisfaction of the Agricultural Committee that it will be required by him during the

current year for building or manufacturing or other revenue producing purposes.

(4) That no compensation shall be paid to any owner or other person interested in such land for or on account of the exercise of the powers conferred by this by-law.

(5) That this By-law shall take effect immediately on the passing thereof.
