Paper & fiber	Cardboard boxes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pizza boxes, direct mail boxes, moving boxes, shoe boxes.</li> </ul>	✓ Flatten. No larger than 60cm x 60cm
	Boxboard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons, rolls from toilet paper and paper towel.</li> </ul>	✓ Flatten.
	Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any colour, including flour bags, prescription bags, paper produce bags.</li> <li>• Notepads, white or coloured loose paper, file folders, other printed materials.</li> <li>• Community newspapers, flyers, brochures and magazines.</li> <li>• Greeting cards and envelopes, gift boxes.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Put shredded paper in a tied clear plastic bag.</li> <li>✓ No elastics.</li> <li>✓ No rope handles.</li> <li>✓ No paperback or hardcover books.</li> </ul>
	Paper laminate packaging	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pet food bags, food service paper bags, and plates.</li> <li>• Spiral cans, cookie dough package, ice cream containers, and hot and cold beverage cups.</li> </ul>	✓ Remove lids.
	Cartons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Beverage cartons, juice and milk cartons, coffee creamers, and sugar cartons, soup and sauce cartons.</li> </ul>	✓ Lids on.
Plastic	Plastic containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Laundry detergent and household cleaner jugs, shampoo, body wash, salad dressing, condiment, dish soap, mouth wash bottles, plastic beverage bottles.</li> <li>• Food trays, salad, yogurt, peanut butter, bakery and egg containers, plastic cups, plastic tubs and lids.</li> <li>• Toothpaste tubes, deodorant, hand cream tubes.</li> <li>• Small item packaging, hand sanitizer bottles, plant pots.</li> </ul>	✓ Lids on.
	Flexible plastic packaging	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bags used for dry cleaning, bread, newspapers and flyers. Overwrap (paper towel &amp; toilet paper, beverage containers). Coffee bags or deli pouches, chip bags, bubble wrap, snack wrappers, cereal liner bags, plastic gift bags.</li> </ul>	
	Foam packaging	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meat trays, takeout containers, cups, plates, bowls, foam packaging.</li> </ul>	✓ Remove film wrap and absorbent pads
Metal	Metal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Food cans, metal lids, cookie, coffee and tea tins, beverage cans.</li> </ul>	
	Aluminum (foils and trays)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Aluminum foil, pie plates, frozen food trays.</li> </ul>	✓ Ball up aluminum foil
	Aerosol containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Food spray, hairspray, air fresheners, shaving cream, deodorant.</li> </ul>	✓ Lids on
Glass	Glass containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clear and coloured glass. Food containers, jars and bottles, cosmetic containers, spice bottles, oil and vinegar bottles, non-alcoholic glass beverage containers.</li> </ul>
