

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2253

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to name an Acting Head of the Municipality.

WHEREAS Chapter 249, Sec. 210(3), R.S.O. 1960, provides for the appointment by by-law of one member to act on all occasions when the head may be absent.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That at any time during the absence of the Mayor, the head of the Municipality, Alderman R. F. DONNELLY shall act in his stead.
2. That Alderman R. F. DONNELLY on such occasions as the Mayor is absent shall fill the position of Deputy Mayor.
3. That in the absence of the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor shall enjoy all the privileges of Mayor and is authorized to execute and sign cheques, notes and other legal documents, that the Mayor were he present and authorized, would execute or sign.
4. That in the absence of the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor shall preside at all regular or special meetings of Council or Committee and represent the Mayor at all functions he may be called upon to attend.
5. That this authority shall terminate automatically on December 31st, 1967.
