BY-LAW NO. 2005-197

**BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE
A PORTION OF THE UNOPENED LINDSAY STREET ROAD
ALLOWANCE ABUTTING LOTS 21 & 22, PLAN M-85,
IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the unopened portion of the Lindsay Street road allowance abutting Lots 21 and 22, Plan M-85 be closed and stopped up;

AND WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2005-572 passed on the 8th day of August, 2005, Council approved the closure of the unopened portion of the Lindsay Street road allowance abutting Lots 21 and 22, Plan M-85;

AND WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2005-398 passed on the 24th day of May, 2005, Council declared the unopened portion of the Lindsay Street road allowance abutting Lots 21 and 22, Plan M-85 to be surplus;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, the Council of the City nor a Committee of said Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That certain part of the unopened portion of the Lindsay Street road allowance abutting Lots 21 and 22, Plan M-85 designated as Part 1 on Reference Plan 36R-9249 is hereby closed and stopped up.
2. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 22ND DAY OF AUGUST, 2005.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 22ND DAY OF AUGUST, 2005.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THE 19TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2005.
