

BY-LAW NO. 1003

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to close part of Third Avenue in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to close a certain portion of Third Avenue at Regina Street within the City of North Bay and to sell or lease the said property.

THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

that

THAT portion of Third Avenue and part of the intersection of Third Avenue and Regina Street, according to a plan of subdivision prepared by J. L. Morris, O.L.S., and registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing, on the 28th day of September 1887, and more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the intersection of the south-easterly limit of Regina Street with the south-westerly limit of Third Avenue according to the said plan, thence south-easterly along the said limit of Third Avenue, eighty feet (80'); thence north-easterly and at right angles with the said limit of Third Avenue, twenty-eight feet (28'); thence north-westerly and parallel with the said limit of Third Avenue, one hundred feet (100'); thence south-westerly and at right angles with the said limit of Third Avenue, twenty-eight feet (28'); thence south-easterly in a straight line to the said place of commencement be, and the same is hereby closed and stopped up.

THAT the said Council shall hear in person or by his or her counsel, Solicitor or Agent any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this By-Law and who applies to be heard.

THAT forthwith upon this By-Law taking effect, the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall lease to William Kennedy & Sons Ltd., the lands herein closed up, for a period of 5 years at the annual rental of \$1.00 per year and for such further periods and upon such terms as may be agreed upon.

THAT this By-Law shall take effect after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks, as provided by the Statutes in this behalf.

Read a Second time in Open Council this 12th day of January, 1931
Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third time short and passed this 16th day of February, 1931.
