BY-LAW NUMBER 604

BEING a By-law to amend By-law Number 525.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to make certain changes in the water rates, in order to prevent continual delay in payment and added expense resulting therefrom,

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED:-

That all rates as shown in Schedule "A" of said By-law 525 shall be increased by Ten Percent (10%).

And that section 42, second paragraph, shall be changed to read as follows:-

"All schedule rates, except meter rates, shall be due and payable quarter-yearly, in advance, at the office of the Water Commissioner, that is to say, on the first day of January, April, July and October. If payment is made within one month of due date, a discount of 10% shall be allowed."

Section 44 shall read as follows:-

"In case of non-payment of rates or rents for thirty days after the expiration of the discount date, the Water Commissioner or his duly-authorized assistant, shall cut off the supply of water from the house, store, office building or part of building upon which the said rate or rent may be due, and the water will not again be turned on, except upon payment of all arrears due, and One Dollar charge for expense of turning water on or off. Except in case of new services, the non-receipt of notice, stating amount of water rates due, shall not be deemed sufficient excuse for non-payment of said water rates or rents, when due."

This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January, 1921/.
