

BY-LAW No. 1745

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to close certain Streets and Lanes in the City of North Bay, said Streets and Lanes being composed of Parts of Lawson Street, Burns Street Lavery Street, Vimy Street, and Reynolds Street, and the 10 foot lanes and 16 foot lanes hereinafter more fully described, all of which streets and lanes are shown on Plan No.78, Registered in the Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

WHEREAS The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to close certain Streets and Lanes as hereinafter more fully described.

THEREFORE under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay by the Municipal Act. being R.S.O. 1950, Chapter 243, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Lawson Street from the north limit of the said plan southerly to a line joining the south east angle of the north 18 feet of Lot 327 with the south west angle of the north 18 feet of Lot 320 of the said plan; IS HEREBY CLOSED AND STOPPED UP.
2. THAT Burns Street from the north limit of the said plan southerly to a line joining the south east angle of Lot 384 with the south west angle of lot 391 of the said plan; IS HEREBY CLOSED AND STOPPED UP.
3. THAT Lavery Street from the west limit of the said plan easterly to the west limit of Lawson Street; IS HEREBY CLOSED AND STOPPED UP.
4. THAT Vimy Street from the west limit of the said plan easterly to a line joining the north east angle of Lot 297 with the south east angle, of Lot 150; IS HEREBY CLOSED AND STOPPED UP.
5. THAT Reynolds Street from the West limit of the said plan easterly to a line joining the south east angle of Lot 39 with the north east angle of Lot 137; IS HEREBY CLOSED AND STOPPED UP.
6. THAT the 10 foot lanes at the rear of the following lots: Lots 65,66 and 67; Lots 83 to 89 inclusive; Lots 358 to 364 inclusive; Lots 381 to 384 inclusive; Lots 64, 63 and 62; Lots 90 to 96 inclusive; Lots 351 to 357 inclusive; Lots 388 to 391 inclusive; Lots 49,50 and 51, Lots 117 to 123 inclusive; Lots 324 to 330 inclusive; Lots 415,416,417 and the north 26 feet of Lot 418; Lots 48,47 and 46; Lots 124 and 130 inclusive; Lots 317, 318, 319 and the north 18 feet of Lot 320; IS HEREBY CLOSED AND STOPPED UP.
7. THAT the 16 foot lanes shown on the said plan lying between Lots 73 to 77 inclusive and Lots 78 to 82 inclusive; between Lots 97 to 106 inclusive and Lots 107 to 116 inclusive; between Lots 131 to 140 and Lots 141 to 150 inclusive; between Lots 365 to 369 inclusive and Lots 370 to 374 inclusive; between Lots 331 to 340 inclusive and Lots 341 to 350 inclusive between Lots 375 to 379 inclusive and Lots 653 to 657 inclusive; between Lots 395 to 404 inclusive and Lots 405 to 414 inclusive and the north half of the 16 foot lane lying between Lots 297 to 306 inclusive and Lots 307 to 316 inclusive; IS HEREBY CLOSED AND STOPPED UP.

The said Streets and Lanes as herein described are shown on a copy of a plan prepared for the purpose of expunging part of the said Registered Plan 78, dated at North Bay, Ontario, 27th January, 1955 signed by E. L. Moore, Ontario Land Surveyor and hereto attached.

8. THAT the Council of the Municipal Corporation in the City of North Bay shall hear in person or by his or her solicitor, counsel, or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this By-Law and who applies to be heard.
9. THAT this By-Law shall take effect upon the passing thereof and after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks as provided by the Statutes in that behalf.
