

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 12-93

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND AND CONSOLIDATE
SNOWMOBILE BY-LAW NO. 20-72.

WHEREAS By-law 20-72 prohibits snowmobiles in certain areas of the City and otherwise restricts the operation of snowmobiles pursuant to the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chap. M-44, s.7.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend By-law 20-72 to exempt police officers while acting in the course of their duty.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to consolidate other amendments made by By-law 21-73 and 19-81.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Sections 2 to 7 of By-law 20-72 are hereby deleted and the following sections inserted in lieu thereof.
2. Sidewalks No person shall bring into or use, drive, operate, draw, haul or propel a motorized snow vehicle along or upon any sidewalk, pathway, footpath or other pedestrian way used by or set apart for the use of pedestrians within the limits of the City.
3. (a) Parks No person shall bring into or use, drive, operate, draw, haul or propel a motorized snow vehicle within any park within the City except those listed in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law and except along such trail.
(b) No person shall bring into or use, drive, operate, draw, haul or propel a motorized snow vehicle within any playground or school yard within the City.
4. (a) Highways Except as permitted by Section 5, no person shall drive or operate a motorized snow vehicle on any highway in the City.
(b) Lakes No person shall drive or operate a motorized snow vehicle on any lake within 500 feet of the closest building on the land unless such motorized snow vehicle is being driven or operated directly from a point on the land to the area where operation is permitted or from such area to a point on the land.
(c) No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle within the area outlined in Schedule "B" attached hereto unless such motorized snow vehicle is being operated for the purpose of moving it by the most direct route between the place where it is normally kept and an area where the operation of motorized snow vehicles is permitted; provided that nothing in this subsection shall be deemed to permit the driving or operating of a motorized snow vehicle on a highway.


5. This by-law shall not apply to prohibit the driving or operation of a motorized snow vehicle on a highway
- Exemptions
- (a) which is not normally plowed by the City for use by motor vehicles during the winter months; or
 - (b) in a parade, contest or special event held under the authority of a permit issued by the Chief of Police of the North Bay Police force;
 - (c) when such vehicle is being driven or operated on the highway only for the purpose of crossing from a point on one side of the highway to a point directly opposite thereto, provided that in crossing a highway the operator or driver of the motorized snow vehicle shall:
 - (a) before entering the highway, bring the motorized snow vehicle to a complete stop; and
 - (b) upon entering the highway, yield the right-of-way to all vehicles on the highway,
 - (d) or elsewhere within the City, by peace officers during the performance of their duty.
6. No person shall park a motorized snow vehicle on any highway.
7. Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be subject to the penalties provided under the Provincial Offences Act.
