BEING an amendment in part of section 10 of By-Law Number 792, being a By-Law to provide for the licensing and regulation of Dogs.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS;-

THAT said section 9 of said By-Law be repealed and the following section substituted therefor:-

"Any duly authorized person may capture any dog found running at large contrary to the provisions of this By-Law and may deliver such dog to the keeper of any dog pound who shall impound the same, and the owner or possessor of such dog may be permitted to redeem the same within forty-eight hours from the time of capture by paying for the use of the City, Three (\$3.00) Dollars for each dog and Seven (\$7.00) Dollars for each bitch (except spayed bitches registered in the Register of the Canadian Kennel Club for which bitches he shall pay the sum of Three (\$3.00) each) and registering and procuring a license for such dogs or bitches under the provisions of section Three of this By-Law. All dogs impounded under the provisions of this By-Law if not redeemed within forty-eight hours after such impounding may be sold.at the price mentioned in this By-Law for redemption, or such higher price as the said Humane Society Inspector may think proper. All dogs not so redeemed or sold shall after forty-eight hours from such impounding be killed in such manner as the Board may approve."

This By-Law shall take effect immediately on the passing thereof.

Read a First Time in Open Council this 20th day of July, 1931. Read a Second Time in Open Council this 20th day of July, 1931. Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third Time short and passed this 20th day of July, 1931.
