BEING a By-Law to amend the Building By-Law No. 318.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to make certain amendments to the Building By-Law No. 318,

BE IT ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted by the Municipality of the Town of North Bay as follows:-

1. That the following words in Clause 2 be eliminated "Except a permit shall not be required for a structure in Class 6, Section 14".
2. That the following words in clause 20, Section 1, (first line) "Except in limit A & B" be eliminated.
3. That the following words in section 5, Clause 20 "Except in limit A & B" be eliminated.
4. That section 1, clause 23 be amended to cover limits A & B by eliminating "C" (last line).
5. That Clauses 92, 93, 94, 95, & 96 be eliminated.
6. That clause 108, Section A & B be made to cover limits A & B only, by adding the words, "This applies to buildings in limits A & B".
7. That the number of the following clauses be changed as follows:- 97 to 92, 98 to 93, 99 to 94, 100 to 95, 101 to 96, 102 to 97, 103 to 98, 104 to 99, 105 to 100, 106 to 101, 107 to 102, 108 to 103, 109 to 104, 110 to 105, 111 to 106, 113 to 107, 114 to 108, 115 to 109.
8. That Clause 112 be repealed.
9. That Clause 115 be repealed and the following substituted as Clause 109.

Clause 109.

Limit A.

Buildings classified 1 and 2 limited to the C. P. R. Railway property on the South, Sherbrooke Street on the East, McIntyre Street on the North, and Cassell Street on the West.

Limit B.

Buildings classified 1, 2, 3, 4, or Buildings Class 5, the cost of which is not less than \$3000.00, outside limit "A" bounded by John Street, Second Avenue, Cassell Street to McPhail Street, Percy Street, Front Street, Klock Avenue, Jane Street, Bell Street, Main Street, Timmins Street, and C. P. Railway on South.

Limit C.

Buildings classified 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, outside limits A & B.

10. That the following new clauses be added:-

Clause 110.

No stable shall be erected within the Municipality of the Town of North Bay, until a permit for such erection has been issued by the Building Inspector with the approval of the Sanitary Inspector.

Clause 111.

Permits may be issued for the erection of garages in limites A & B constructed of brick, corrugated steel, galvanized iron, or other non-combustible material, dimensions to be not less than 12 X 20 feet.

Clause 112.

The Building Inspector may issue permits for the use of incinerators within the Town of North Bay, if he considers such incinerators safe.

11. That Clause 117 be repealed and the following substituted as Clause 113.

Clause 113.

"That the Fire Chief be, and is hereby appointed Building Inspector, and that the appointment of the Fire Chief as such Building Inspector be without salary".

12. That Clause 116 be numbered 114, and clause 118 be numbered 115.

13. That a clause regarding appeal to Council from decision of building Inspector as added by By-Law 631 be numbered 116.

14. That Section 5, Clause 14, be repealed and the following substituted:-

"Fifth Class Buildings:- Mean frame structures covered with galvanized iron, corrugated or otherwise, metallic siding, or a good frame structure, after plans have been approved by the Building Inspector"

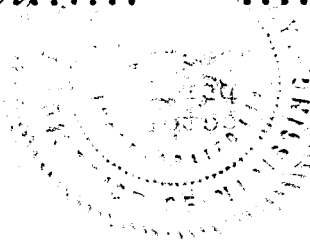
