BEING A BY-LAW to appoint two members of the TOWN PLANNING COMMISSION for the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS IT IS NECESSARY to pass a By-Law to provide for the appointment of Two Members of the Town Planning Commission for the City of North Bay to replace Messrs. E. L. Moore and A. B. McKenzie, whose terms of office expire on the 31st. day of December, 1933.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the following named persons be and are hereby appointed members of the Town Planning Commission for the City of North Bay, viz:

E. L. MOORE


H. J. McAUSLAN
