BY-LAW NO. 2001-127

BEING A BY-LAW TO ASSIGN  
NAMES TO CERTAIN STREETS AND  
ROADS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS the approval to rename or name certain streets and roads in the City of North Bay was given by Council by Resolution No. 2001-571 on September 10, 2001;

AND WHEREAS Council may name streets within the City of North Bay pursuant to *Section 210 (111) of the Municipal Act, R.S. O. 1990, Chapter M-45*;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to change the name of a street or assign the name to a street in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS before passage of this by-law, notice of the same was published at least once a week for four (4) successive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS before the passage of this by-law the Council of the City of North Bay shall hear any person who claims that he will be adversely affected by the by-law and applies to be heard;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Mark Street be renamed "Elks Lane".
2. That the roadway running southwesterly from Airport Road to the North Bay Lookout be named "Lookout Heights Place".
3. That the westerly extension of Mud Lake Road that connects to Patton Road be renamed "Patton Road".
4. This By-law comes into force and effect upon registration of a copy of this by-law, certified under the hand of the Clerk and the seal of The Corporation of the City of North Bay in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 9<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER, 2001.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 3<sup>RD</sup> DAY OF DECEMBER, 2001.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 3<sup>RD</sup> DAY OF DECEMBER, 2001.
