BY-LAW NO. 91-77

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 69-77  
BEING A BY-LAW TO IMPOSE RESTRICTIONS ON  
THE USE OF CERTAIN LANDS IN THE CITY OF  
NORTH BAY

WHEREAS the Ministry of Housing has withdrawn the condition requiring the passage of a geodetic by-law prior to final registration of the plan of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS the Council by Resolution No. 30 passed at its regular meeting held Monday, 13 June, 1977 authorized that By-law No. 69-77 be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 69-77 being a by-law to impose restriction on certain lands in the City of North Bay be and is hereby repealed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 27TH DAY OF JUNE, 1977.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 11TH DAY OF JULY, 1977

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 11TH DAY OF JULY, 1977.
