## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW No. 84-97

## BEING A BY-LAW TO EXEMPT CERTAIN MUNICIPAL AND UTILITY VEHICLES FROM WEIGHT AND SIZE RESTRICTIONS.

WHEREAS Part VIII, Sections 114 to 127, of the Highway Traffic Act, regulates the weight of vehicles on highways; and section 109 regulates the dimensions of certain vehicles.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to exempt certain municipal and utility emergency and road maintenance vehicles from such limits;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Traffic By-law No. 131-93 is hereby amended by adding the following section:
  - 36.1 (1) Section 109 and Part VIII of the Highway Traffic Act do not apply to:
    - (a) vehicles operated by or on behalf of the municipality, where the vehicles are engaged in highway maintenance, including the carriage and application of abrasives or chemicals to the highway, the stockpiling of abrasives or chemicals for use on a highway, or the removal of snow from a highway;
    - (b) fire apparatus;
    - (c) vehicles operated by or on behalf of the municipality transporting waste; or
    - (d) public utility emergency vehicles.
    - (2) The Director of Engineering and Works is hereby authorized to grant permits:
      - (a) for all vehicles set out in paragraph (1) and
      - (b) upon receipt of an application in writing, for a limited time and place, subject to relevant conditions, and financial security for the protection of the highway, persons and property, for the moving of heavy or oversize vehicles and to impose an administrative fee of \$500.00 therefore.
