TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A PETTY CASH FUND.


WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, c. 284,  
s. 220 (2) (4) authorizes the Treasurer, with the approval  
of council, to establish and maintain a petty cash fund.

AND WHEREAS it is considered desirable to establish  
and maintain a petty cash fund.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF  
NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered  
to establish and maintain a petty cash fund at  
the maximum amounts as set out in Schedule "A"  
attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
2. This by-law shall become effective when passed  
by council.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 9TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1973.  
READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 22ND DAY OF OCTOBER, 1973.  
READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED  
THIS 22ND DAY OF OCTOBER, 1973.
