

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 133-98

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERMUNICIPAL SERVICE AGREEMENT DATED THE 26TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1998 BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AND ITS MUNICIPAL PARTNERS RELATING TO THE TRANSFER OF SERVICE DELIVERY FOR ALL COURT ADMINISTRATION AND COURT FUNCTIONS UNDER THE *PROVINCIAL OFFENCES ACT* AND THE PROSECUTIONS OF MATTERS COMMENCED UNDER PARTS I AND II OF THE ACT.

WHEREAS the Province requires an Intermunicipal Service Agreement to be made in support of a Memorandum of Understanding for the transfer of service delivery for all Court Administration and Court Support functions under the *Provincial Offences Act* and the prosecutions of matters commenced under Parts 1 and II of the Act;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Partners have agreed to The Corporation of the City of North Bay being the service delivery agent to effect a seamless transition of POA court administration and to sharing the net revenues on a population basis amongst the Municipal Partners.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That The Corporation of the City of North Bay enter into an Intermunicipal Service Agreement with its Municipal Partners dated the 26th day of October, 1998 relating to the transfer of service delivery for all Court Administration and Court Support functions under the *Provincial Offences Act* and the prosecutions of matters commenced under Parts 1 and II of the Act.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the City of North Bay are hereby authorized to execute that certain Intermunicipal Service Agreement between The Corporation of the City of North Bay and its Municipal Partners and to affix thereto the corporate seal.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 26TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1998.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 26TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1998.
