

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 141-86

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 104-86  
TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE MAIN STREET FROM  
FRASER STREET TO FERGUSON STREET AND  
BETWEEN FERGUSON STREET AND WYLD STREET.

WHEREAS the Council deems that a pedestrian mall on Main Street would serve a useful social, recreational and community purpose, and

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area Board of Management, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close portions of Main Street pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, section 208, subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 104-86 be amended by deleting Clause No. 1 from the by-law and inserting in lieu thereof the following Clause No. 1:

"Subject to section 2 hereof, that portion of Main Street from Fraser Street to Ferguson Street and from Ferguson Street to Wyld Street in the City of North Bay shall be closed to vehicular traffic from 9 o'clock in the forenoon on Fridays until 5 o'clock in the afternoon on Saturdays, commencing July 4, 1986, to and including August 30, 1986, except for the following days:

August 2, 1986, when they shall be closed until 11:30 p.m., and


August 23, 1986, when they shall be closed until 11:30 p.m., and

August 9, 1986, when they shall be closed until 11:30 p.m."

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 21ST DAY OF JULY, 1986.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 5th DAY OF August, 1986.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 5th DAY OF August, 1986.
