

BY-LAW NO. 1706

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY PRESENTLY LOCATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WIDDIFIELD.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to apply for the annexation of certain property as hereinafter described situate in the Township of Widdifield.

AND WHEREAS the owners of the said property are desirous of amalgamating with the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS the said City of North Bay find it necessary for its ordinary expansion to annex additional territory.

THEREFORE, THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY UNDER PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL ACT, BEING R.S.O. 1950, Chapter 243, more particularly Section 20, ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. That an application be made to the Municipal Board of the Province of Ontario to annex to the said City of North Bay that certain property owned by Pinewood Village Limited, being part of Lot 22, Concession "C" Township of Widdifield as described in a proposed subdivision plan dated November 6th, 1952, certified by A.C. Ingram known as Plan No. 2, comprising 160 acres more or less.
2. That the necessary application be forwarded to the Municipal Board immediately on the passing of this By-Law.

UPON THE APPLICATION of the Corporation of the City of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing, and pursuant to Appointment for Hearing issued by The Ontario Municipal Board under date of the 9th day of February, A. D., 1954, and in the presence of Counsel for the Township of Widdifield and the Corporation of the City of North Bay, and upon hearing the evidence adduced and what was alleged by Counsel aforesaid;

1: IT IS ORDERED that part of the Township of Widdifield described as follows: That portion of the Township of Widdifield comprising part of original Township Lot 22, Concession "C" of said Township containing an area of 180 acres, be the same more or less and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwesterly angle of Lot 22, Concession "C";

Thence Easterly along the Northerly boundary of said Lot 22 to the Northeasterly angle thereof;

Thence Southerly along the Easterly boundary of said Lot 22 to an angle in the limit of the Town of North Bay as incorporated April Seventh, A. D. 1890, being a point in the Northeasterly boundary of James Street (now known as Jane Street), said point being more particularly described in said Act of Incorporation as being an angle of the boundary of the Murray Ward;

Thence Northwesterly along the said Northeasterly boundary of said James Street (described in said Act of Incorporation as a boundary of the Murray Ward), to intersection with the production North-easterly of the Northwesterly boundary of Stevens Street (formerly known as John Street), said point of intersection being described as an angle in the boundary of the Murray Ward in the said Act of Incorporation;

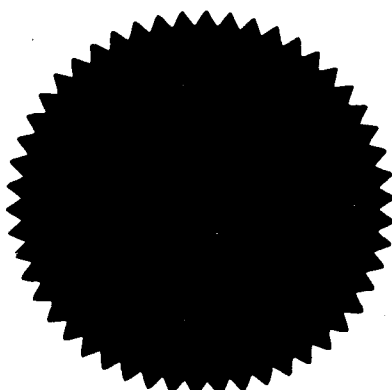
Thence West astronomically to the intersection with the Westerly boundary of said Lot 22;

Thence Northerly along the said Westerly boundary of Lot 22 to the point of commencement;

be annexed to and form part of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.

2. AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of such annexation shall be the first day of April, A. D., 1954, and that adjustments of assets and liabilities be arranged between the said Municipalities as of that date; failing such arrangement, further application may be made to this Board for such purpose.

The Applicant Corporation shall pay to the Board the sum of \$60.10 being the Official Reporter's fee for taking and transcribing the notes of evidence. There shall be no further order as to costs.

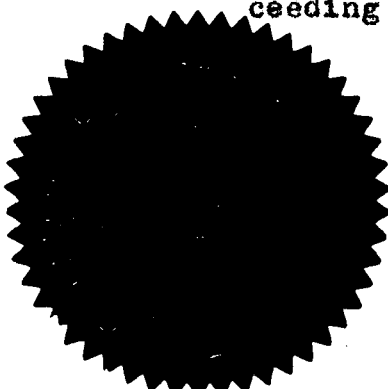
