

BY-LAW NO. 1259.

BEING A BY-LAW to repeal By-Law No. 1257.

WHEREAS BY-LAW No. 1257 was a By-Law authorizing the Corporation of the City of North Bay to borrow the sum of \$200,000.00 from the Royal Bank of Canada for current year's expenditures until current year's revenues are collected.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to repeal said By-Law No. 1257.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT By-Law No. 1257 be repealed and the same is hereby repealed.
