## **BY-LAW NO. 2012-53**

## BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, CLOSE AND CONVEY A PORTION OF THE UNOPENED ALEXANDER ROAD ALLOWANCE IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

**WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that portion of the unopened Alexander Road allowance, in a block bounded by Laurentian Avenue, Kingsway Avenue and Queensway Road abutting Lots 11 and 12, Plan M-258 be closed and stopped up;

**AND WHEREAS** by Resolution No. 2010-615 passed on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010, Council approved the closure of the unopened Alexander Road allowance;

**AND WHEREAS** the unopened Alexander Road allowance abutting Lots 11 and 12, Plan M-258 is hereby declared to be surplus;

**AND WHEREAS** notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

**AND WHEREAS** no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, the Council of the City nor a Committee of said Council;

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That certain part of the unopened Alexander Road allowance abutting Lots 11 and 12, Plan M-258 and designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Reference Plan 36R-13218 is hereby closed and stopped up.
- 2. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 21ST DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2012.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 21ST DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2012.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THE 19<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF MARCH, 2012.
