

BY-LAW NUMBER 819

BEING a By-law to amend By-law Number Seven Hundred and Ninety-Two of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to amend By-law Number Seven Hundred and Ninety-two, being a By-law to provide for the licensing and regulation of dogs.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

THAT Paragraph Five of By-law Number Seven Hundred and Ninety-two be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following Paragraph Five be substituted therefore.

From the First day of May in any year to the First day of November, both days inclusive in the same year, no person shall allow his dog to run at large in any of the Public parks, squares, drives, streets, lanes, alleys or other public places in the City of North Bay, unless such dog is accompanied by and is under the immediate charge and control of some competent person, and any dog found running at large, contrary to this provision shall be liable to be captured and disposed of as hereinbefore provided.

This by-law shall take effect immediately on the passing thereof.
