

BY-LAW NO. 2193

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay for the closing of part of a certain lane lying between Lots 478 and 481, Plan M-189 in the City of North Bay as shown on Plan NR-1010 in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay, Ontario.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to close a certain part of the above mentioned lane and to sell and convey the same to the owner of the lands adjoining same.

AND WHEREAS Notice of the intention of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to close same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the local newspaper.

AND WHEREAS the said Council has undertaken to hear in person or by their counsel, solicitor or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applies to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That all and singular that part of a certain lane lying between lots 478 and 481 Plan M-189 as shown on a Plan signed by William E. Bolan, O.L.S. dated September 26th, 1964, of record in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay, Ontario as Plan NR-1010 and designated thereon as Part 1 be and the same is hereby closed and stopped up.
2. That the said part of such lane hereby closed be made the subject of an Application to the Local Master of Titles to have the above mentioned registered Plan amended and revised accordingly.
