

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAYBY-LAW NO. 1-72

BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT GEORGE DAVID OLAH AS CITY SOLICITOR ON A FULL TIME BASIS AS A SALARIED OFFICER AND EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS *it is deemed expedient to appoint George David Olah as City Solicitor on a full time basis for the purposes of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.*

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT George David Olah be and is hereby appointed and employed as City Solicitor for the City of North Bay on a full time basis commencing January 1, 1972.
2. THAT the said Solicitor shall carry out and perform the usual duties devolving upon a City Solicitor and such other duties as the Council may, from time to time prescribe.
3. THAT By-law 65-69 is hereby repealed.
4. This By-law shall come into full force and effect as of the date hereof and shall remain in full force and effect from year to year until repealed.
