THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 32-85

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW NO. 2-82 REGARDING LOADING ZONES.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend Traffic By-law No. 2-82 as to the regulation of the use of loading zones.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 24 of By-law No. 2-82 is hereby deleted and the following sections inserted in lieu thereof:
 - "24 (1) In this section,
 - "Commercial Motor Vehicles" means a motor vehicle which is identified by a sign painted on or firmly attached to the outside of the vehicle, which bears the name or style of the business and which vehicle is used for the purpose of delivery of materials.
 - (2) Loading zones are hereby established on those portions of the highway set out on Schedule 15 of this by-law.
 - (3) No person shall park a commercial motor vehicle in a loading zone except while actively engaged in loading or unloading materials.
 - (4) No person shall park a commercial motor vehicle in a loading zone for more than twenty (20) minutes.
 - (5) No driver of a vehicle shall stand a vehicle perpendicular to the curb except:
 - (a) when loading or unloading materials, and
 - (b) the vehicle is a semi-trailer or trailer combination whereby the motor vehicle or truck tractor unit thereof stands parallel to the curb and faced in the direction of going traffic; and
 - (c) the vehicle does not interfere with or interrupt the passage of traffic.

- (6) No person shall transfer merchandise or materials of any kind from a commercial motor vehicle to another vehicle on any street except in the event of mechanical failure or breakdown.
- 2. Section 35 (1) of By-law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by inserting the numeral "24" after the numeral "21" in the second line thereof
- 3. Section 35 (2) of By-law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by inserting the words "or 24" after the numeral "11" in the second line thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 18th DAY OF MARCH , 1985.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 15th DAY OF APRIL , 1985.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 15th DAY OF APRIL , 1985.
