BY-LAW NO. 144-87

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE PARTICI-PATION COSTS FOR COMPUTER HARDWARE, SOFTWARE, AND ALL SUPPORT FACILITIES FOR AN ONTARIO MUNICIPAL POLICE AUTOMATION CO-OPERATIVE (O.M.P.A.C.) COMPUTER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to provide for participation costs for the computer hardware, software and all support facilities for an Ontario Municipal Police Automation Co-operative (O.M.P.A.C.) Computer System at an estimated cost of \$200,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the sum of \$200,000.00 be provided for the participation costs for computer hardware, software and all support facilities for an Ontario Municipal Police Automation Co-operative (0.M.P.A.C.) Computer System.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to cause a contract for the participation costs for computer hardware, software and all support facilities for an Ontario Municipal Police Automation Co-operative (O.M.P.A.C.) Computer System.
- 3. The total estimated cost of the participation costs is \$200,000.00 and is to be debentured over a period of ten (10) years. The participation costs for computer hardware, software and all support facilities for an Ontario Municipal Police Automation Co-operative (O.M.P.A.C.) Computer System shall be as shown on Schedule 'A' attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
- 4. That the Treasurer of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to borrow from time to time from any bank or person by way of promissory note or notes temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the participation costs of the aforesaid pending the issue and sale of the debentures hereinbefore referred to but in no event shall the aggregate of such borrowing exceed the amount limited in this by-law.
- 5. Any promissory note or notes issued pursuant to Paragraph 4 hereof shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation of the City of North Bay and signed by the Mayor or Deputy Mayor and the Treasurer of the City of North Bay.
- 6. That this by-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 64(1) of The Ontario Municipal Board Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 347.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST, 1987.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST, 1987.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 26TH DAY OF OCTOBER , 1987.
