Appendix A - Application Summary(s)

1) B-11 -25 (Consent to Sever):

A Consent to Sever application has been submitted by Tulloch Inc. on behalf of 1000509704 Ontario Inc. owner of 104 and 116 Highland Rd., requesting to sever 439.7m², in order to create separate parcels as a result of the properties merging under the Planning Act. A concurrent Minor Variance application (A-25-25) has been submitted with this application.

2) Concurrent A-25-25 (Minor Variance):

A Minor Variance application has been submitted by Tulloch Inc. on behalf of 1000509704 Ontario Inc, seeking relief from Zoning By-Law 2015-30, as follows:

- a) Table 6C, Reduce Min. Front and North Side Yard Setbacks from 7m to 0.25m
- b) Table 6C, Reduce Min. South Side Yard Setback from 7m to 0.65m and Rear Yard Setback from 10m to 0.65m
- c) Table 6C, Increase Max Lot Coverage from 30% to 35%
- d) Section 4.13.1, Reduce the required onsite parking from 30 spaces to 3 spaces, with the intent to provide 22 spaces on abutting leased land.
- e) Section 3.45 & 3.45.2, Remove the required 3m landscaped strip along lot lines. for the purpose of constructing a 3-storey professional office building at 104 Highland Rd. A concurrent Consent to Sever application (B-11-25) has been submitted with this application.
