

BY-LAW NO. 2160

A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to amend By-law 2115 a by-law to authorize construction of replacement concrete sidewalks on certain streets in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS a petition of objection to the placement of a concrete walk on Sixth Avenue, East Side, from Fraser Street to Ferguson Street has been received by City Council, and


WHEREAS Council by Resolution No. 2 of June 10th, 1964 have authorized the deletion of said walk on Sixth Avenue

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Schedule "A" of By-law 2115 be amended by deleting therefrom Item No. 7, being Sixth Avenue, East Side, from Fraser Street to Ferguson Street in the amount of \$3,539.43.
2. THAT Schedule "A" aforesaid be further amended by deducting from the total estimated cost the amount of \$3,539.43 so that the total now reads \$25,286.71.
3. THIS BY-LAW shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 64 of The Ontario Municipal Board Act, Chapter 274, R.S.O. 1960.


