

BY-LAW NO. 1084

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to repeal By-Law No. 1081 passed on the 7th. day of November, 1932.

WHEREAS By-Law No. 1081 of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay was passed on the 7th. day of November, 1932, to provide for the borrowing of the sum of \$17,501.74 upon debentures to pay for the construction of granolithic sidewalks on certain streets in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS it is requisite that certain portions should be deleted from the said By-Law.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT BY-LAW No. 1081 passed by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay on the 7th. day of November, 1932, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third Time short and passed this 8th. day of December, 1932.
