

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 69-93

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A
PORTION OF FRASER STREET AND MAIN STREET
DURING 1993.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Fraser Street, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, Section 207, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the portion of Fraser Street from Main Street to Algonquin Avenue in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 11:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Tuesday, June 1, 1993, for the purpose of an "Up With People" Parade.
2. That the portion of Main Street from Fraser to Ferguson Streets in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 8:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Friday, July 30, 1993, for the purpose of a "Salute to Seniors" Promotion.
3. That the portion of Main Street from Wyld to Ferguson Streets and Ferguson to Fraser Streets in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon until 9:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Friday, December 3, 1993, for the purpose of a "Christmas Walk" Promotion.
4. That the portion of Main Street from Wyld to Ferguson Streets in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 8:00 o'clock in the forenoon to 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Saturday, August 28, 1993, for the purpose of a "Big Bargain Bonanza Garage Sale".
5. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
6. That prior to the start of each event mentioned in Clauses 1 to 4 inclusive of this by-law, the Director of Transportation and Works will attend to the restoration of the said portions of the aforementioned streets to their condition prior to the above closures.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 31ST DAY OF MAY, 1993.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 31ST DAY OF MAY, 1993.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND PASSED THIS 31ST DAY OF MAY, 1993.
