

BY-LAW NO. 1145

BEING A BY-LAW to appoint a Pumper and Pumper's Assistant for the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is necessary for the Corporation of the City of North Bay to appoint a Pumper and an Assistant Pumper in connection with the management of the Pumhouse and fix remuneration for the service rendered by said parties.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That By-Law Numbers 878 and 1109 and all other By-Laws dealing with Pumpers and Pumper's Assistants be and the same are hereby repealed.
2. That W. E. CALLOWAY be appointed Pumper with charge of the Pumhouse and machinery and equipment therein and that C. F. MORRIS be appointed his assistant in connection with the said work.
3. That W. E. CALLOWAY so appointed shall receive a remuneration semi-monthly, the sum of \$1,200.00 per annum.
4. That C. F. MORRIS shall receive a remuneration semi-monthly of the sum of \$960.00 per annum.
5. That W. E. CALLOWAY shall be given a free house in addition to the said salary.
6. This By-Law to be effective as of the 1st day of February, A. D. 1934.
